



Dr. Philippe G. Nell is Honorary Ambassador of the Latin American Chamber of Commerce in Switzerland and University Lecturer on trade, investment and integration policy as well as negotiating techniques. Presently, he teaches a trade policy course at the University of Fribourg.

Until October 2019, he was Deputy Assistant Secretary for Bilateral Economic Affairs and Head of the Americas Unit at the State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) of the Swiss Department of Economic Affairs, Education and Research. He was in charge of bilateral trade and investment relations and held the diplomatic title of Minister.

Previously, he held the positions of Deputy Head of the WTO Unit of SECO (1999-2004) in charge i.a. of investment and China's accession to the WTO; Head of the Unit on Rules of origin, Customs matters and Government Procurement (1992-99) and Secretary of the High-Level Negotiating Group of the European Area Agreement (1988-92).

Mr. Nell holds a Ph. D from the Graduate School of International Studies of the University of Denver and Masters from the Universities of Fribourg, Carleton (Ottawa) and Denver. He is Privat Dozent at the University of Fribourg where he dispenses courses. He has also taught i.a. at the Europa Institute of the University of Basel (1993-2016), EU Business School (2000-2012), the Universidad Mayor Nacional de San Marcos in Lima (2018), the Universidad de Chile (2018) and the Universidad Paraguayo Alemana (Asuncion, 2019). He has published numerous articles on trade and integration policy as well as a book on Swiss-EU negotiations for the European Economic Area in 2012.
